A Guide to U.S. University Admissions

The University Counseling program is offered to all Dual Diploma students. The program is designed to further prepare students for university and offers earned admissions into one of our 15 partner universities. Students will meet with a guidance counselor throughout the program and attend seminars that guide them through the U.S. admission process and what to expect when studying at a U.S. university.

UNIVERSITY COUNSELING FOR DUAL DIPLOMA STUDENTS

Academic Skill Building

Counselors host workshops and seminars focused on developing academic skills required in the university classroom, including research papers, analytical reading, presentations, and more.

Academic & Career Planning

Counselors explore academic and career interests to help students determine possible university majors. Counselors will also later help students select a major and find the best university fit for them.

Goal Setting

Counselors work with students to understand the importance of goal setting and help them establish their own academic goals.

University Counseling Services

Grades 8-12

Cultural Competency

Students learn about the American culture and academic expectations as they prepare for attending a U.S. University.

Student Advising

Counselors conduct scheduled advising sessions with students to review academic progress and help prepare students for the admissions process.

University Admissions*

Counselors help students navigate the U.S. university admissions process. Counselors help with everything from U.S. requirements & regulations to providing guidance counselor recommendations.
