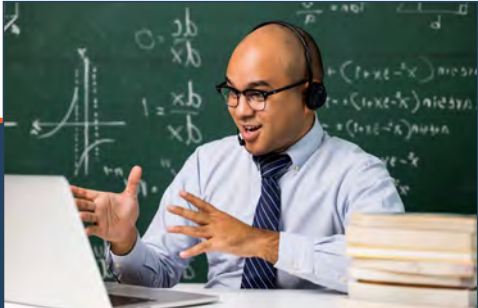

Our Admissions Guarantee

Successful U.S. Dual Diploma graduates with a GPA of at least 2.5 are guaranteed admission* to at least one of more than 30 participating universities, or we will refund their program fee.

Simplified Admissions

Students apply to universities in our guarantee program using a streamlined application process that **waives the SAT, ACT, A-levels, and TOEFL.**** Most admissions decisions are made within 30 days.



Guaranteed Scholarships

Qualified graduates receive scholarships for U.S. universities ranging from \$1,500 to \$20,000 USD. Amounts are determined based on the student's academic record and the university and program selected.

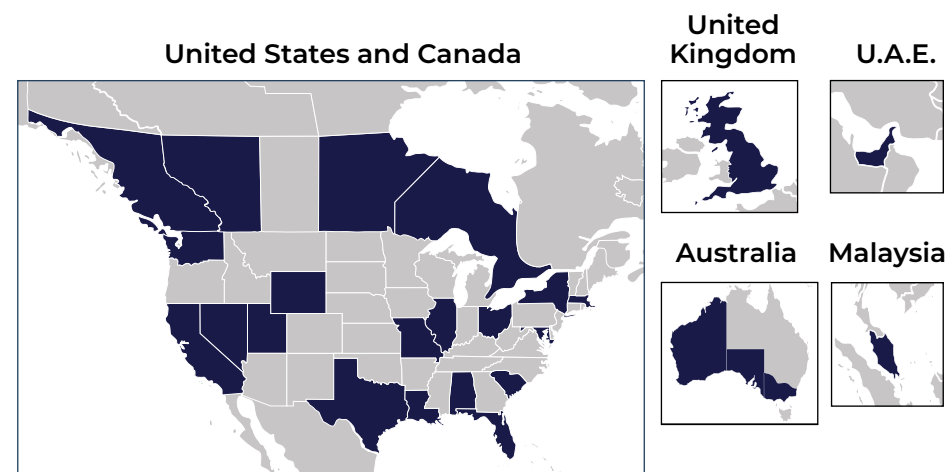
Free advising helps students navigate the admissions system for universities in our network. Expert advisors offer individualized services—from consulting to applications to visa support.

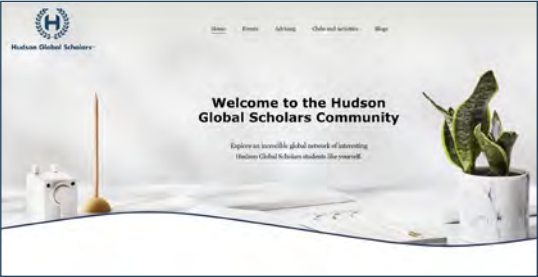
