



At Florida International University, students and faculty are challenged to find innovative solutions to global problems. Our researchers create neural-enabled prosthetics, conduct hurricane research and solve infrastructure issues.



Home of the Aquanauts

Marine biologists, scientists and oceanographers live underwater for 10-day missions collecting data for eight to nine hours per day. In a small 43 foot-long laboratory space, these "aquanauts" live, work, eat and sleep more than 60 feet below the ocean's surface. Research revolves around ocean health, including warming water temperatures, pollution, coral health and testing marine life for viruses and diseases.

FIU's Aquarius Reef Base — located five miles off the coast of Key Largo in the Florida Keys — is the world's only permanent underwater research laboratory. The Medina Aquarius Program is dedicated to oceanic studies, preserving coral reefs and marine ecosystems and developing state-of-the-art undersea technology.

Also at Aquarius:

- NASA astronauts train for International Space Station missions.
- The U.S. Navy conducts readiness training missions.
- Marine biologists and scientists conduct oceanic research projects.

Aquarius has supported more than 120 missions and has produced over 600 peer-reviewed scientific publications.

South Beach Wine & Food Festival (SOBEWFF®)


