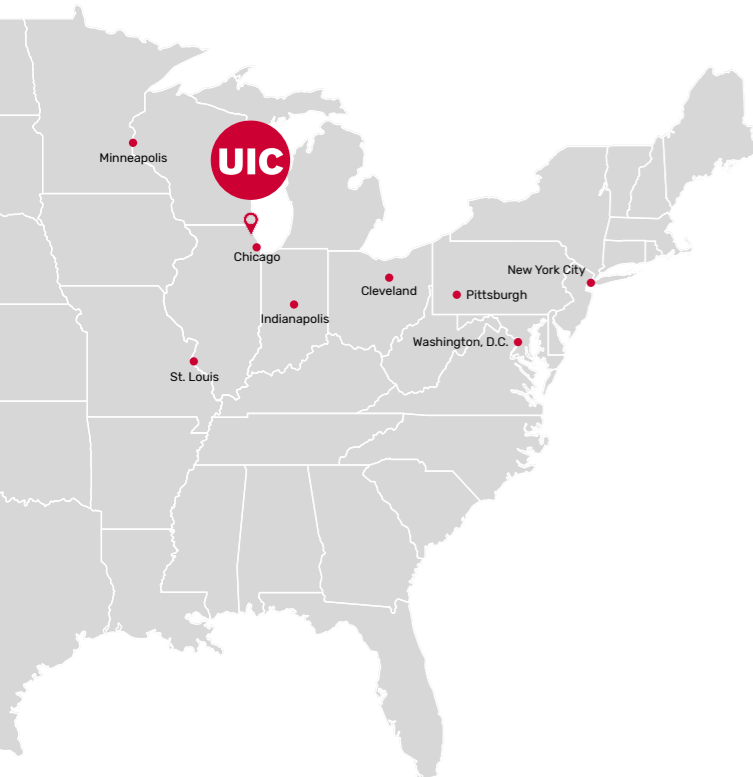

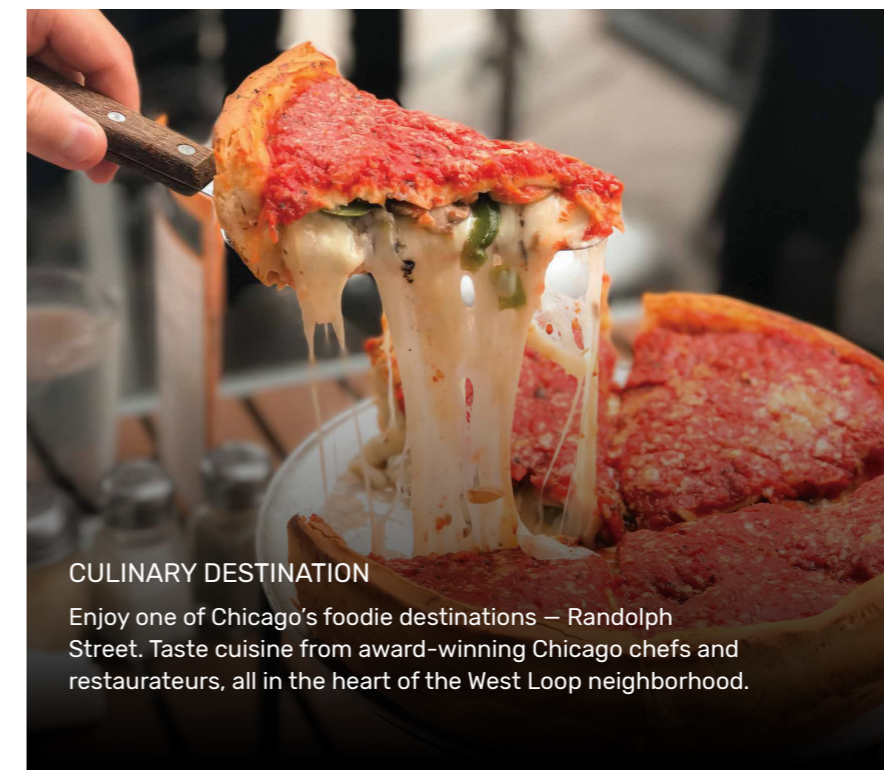

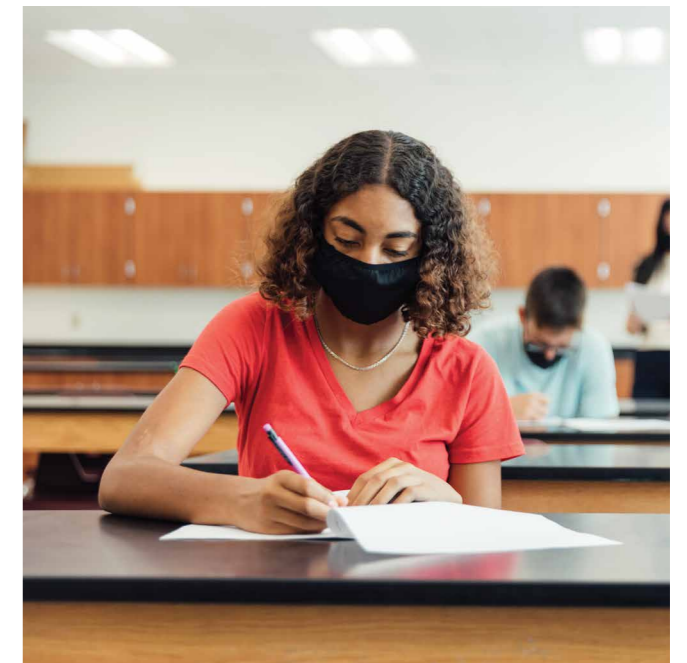

UIC Leads COVID-19 Public Health Efforts

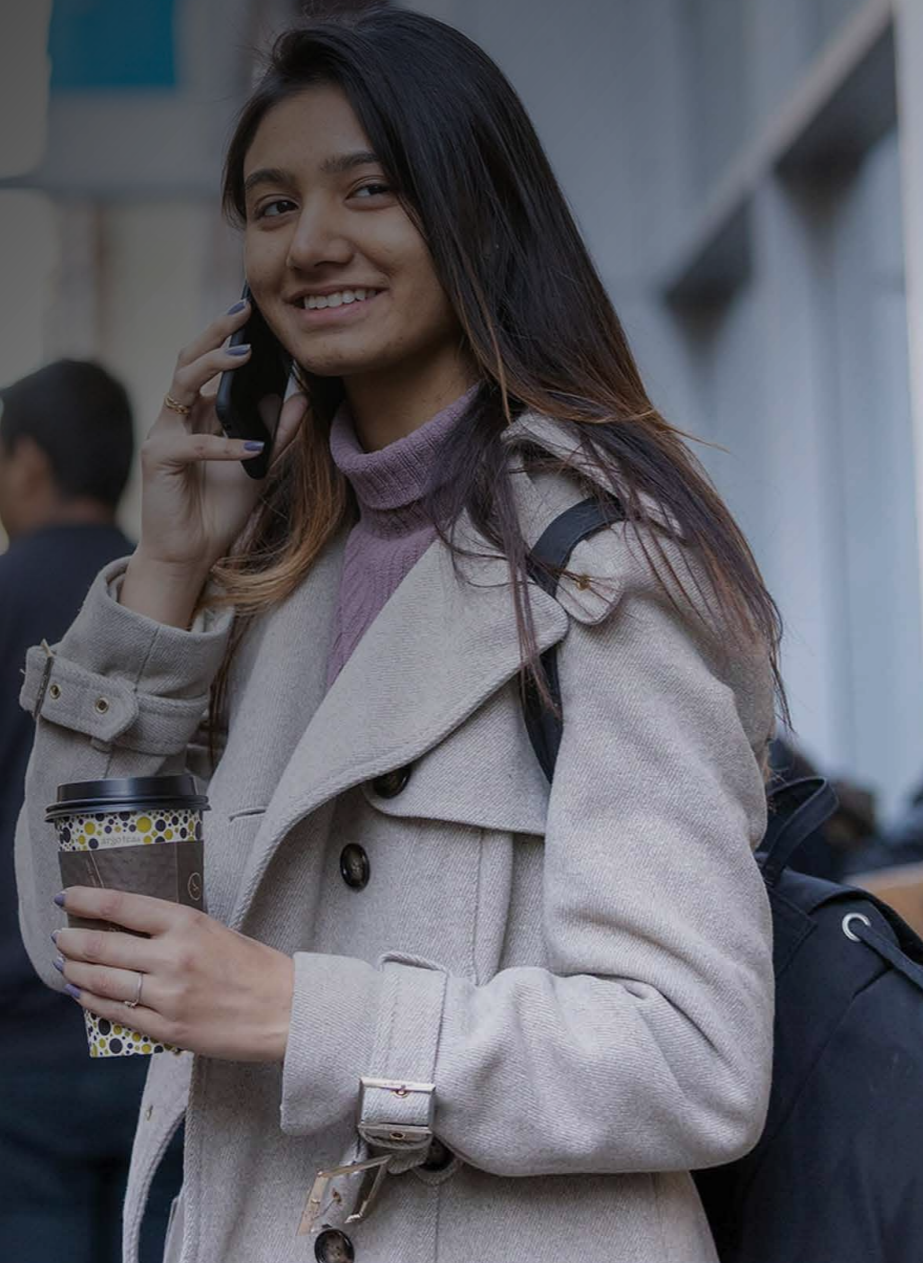
UIC partnered with biotech company Moderna and the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases to test vaccines targeting the novel coronavirus – and it was the first site in Chicago to launch phase 3 trials. In fall 2020, UIC announced a second vaccine study in collaboration with Johnson & Johnson to serve vulnerable populations of color.

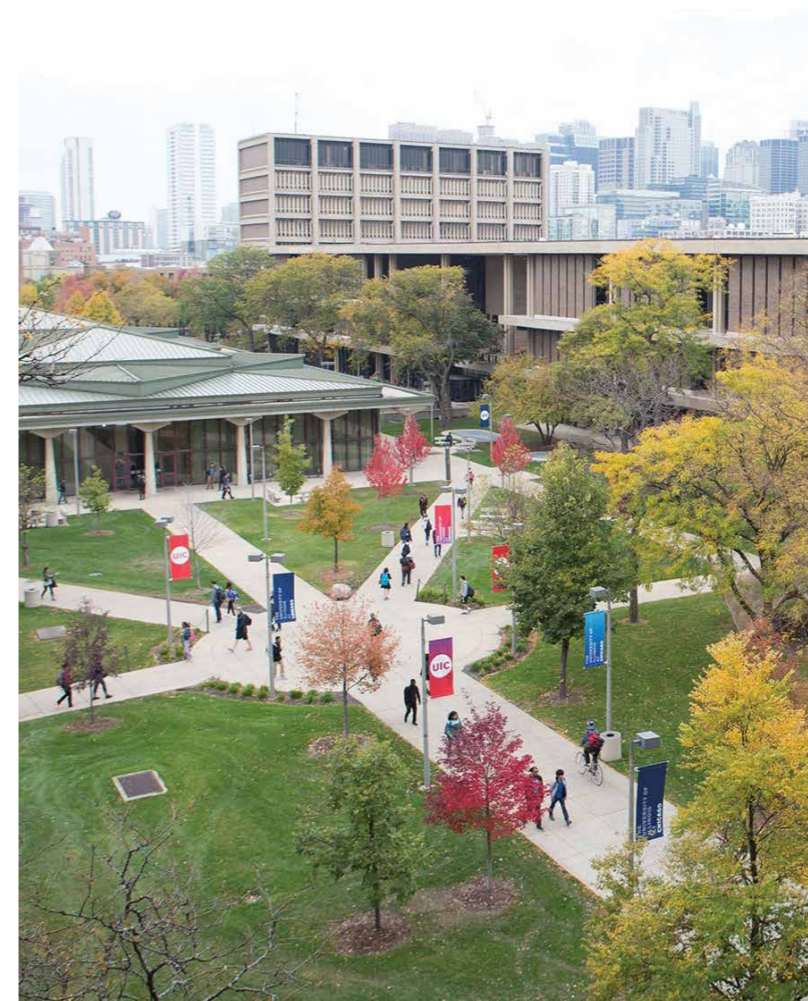

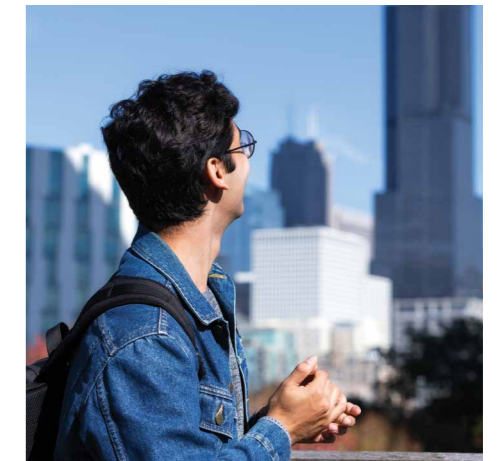
